## Butztown Flier May Be Safe, Parents Feel

Most members of the crew of the bomber on which Lt. Ronald Whitehead of Butztown made his last mission before being reported missing over Yugoslavia, January 24, have been reperted as prisoners of the German government. This fact was revealed in letters received by Lt. Whitehead's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Raymond C. Whitehead.

It is reasonable to feel hopeful

that Lt. Whitehead may be safe son, where, either as a prisoner of war or "on his own" some place waiting an opportunity to find his way back to Allied territory.
