Louis H. A. Feher, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Feher, 1605 East Third Street, who has been promoted from First Lieutenant to the rank of Captain, as announced by Provisional Headquarters, Army Air Force, Middle Pacific. A Signal Corps veteran who served three years overseas in the capacity of Radar and Electronics Officer, Captain Feher has just completed a 45-day furlough at home, where he was informed by telegram of his advancement. A graduate of Lehigh University in 1940 he was employed as assistant plant engineer at Lehigh Structural Steel Company, Allentown, when he was inducted in 1941. He received his basic training in the Engineer Corps and obtained his commission in the Signal Corps and was sent to England in January, 1942. He was subsequently transferred to the Pacific in March, 1943, and became a first lieutenant in June, 1943. Captain Feher will report for duty at Greensboro, N. C.
