## Wounded

Gunnery Sergeant John F. Lehman, U. S. M. C., has been reported wounded in action August 9, 1944, according to a telegram received from the War Department yesterday by his parents, Mr. and Mrs. George Lehman, 608 Atlantic Street.

Prior to enlisting in the Marine Corps, June 22, 1939, he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. After receiving training at camps in South Carolina and Virginia, Sgt. Lehman was sent to Cuba. He had taken part in the fighting at Bougainville, Guadalcanal, Saipan and most recently, Guam. A brother, Pfc. William Lehman is spending a 10-day furlough with his parents.
