Bronze Star Medal



WITH THE SEVENTH ARMY—
For meritorious service, Tec 5 Stephen J. Czor, 20, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Czor of 1719 W. Broad Street, Bethlehem, Pa., has been awarded the Bronze Star Medal by Maj. Gen. Frank W. Milburn, Commanding General of a U. S. Army Corps in France.

Cpl. Czor was cited for devotion to duty as a Signal Corps telephone switchboard operator while enemy

artillery shells were being directed at the house in which he was working. By remaining at his post, communications between a Corps headquarters and units in the field were maintained, thus contributing materially to the Corps' successful drive to push the Germans across the Rhine in that sector.

A graduate of the Bethlehem high school, Cpl. Czor was inducted into the Army in July, 1943, and came overseas in the fall of 1944.
