Having completed special training at Shoemaker, Calif., Raymond Edward Reph, son of Mr. and Rev. Mary A. Reph, 1514 Madison Avenue, has been advanced to Seaman 1/C.

S. 1/C Reph entered ROTC a year ago, September 1, and trained at Chattanooga, Tenn.
