Mr. and Mrs. Anthony Kubat, 917 East Seventh Street, received word of the promotion of their two sons. Steve Kubat, now a Corporal, entered the Army August 9, 1943, and was sent to Lafayette College in Easton. He was transferred to Radio School at Sioux Falls S. D., and Gunnery School at Yuma, Ariz., where he received his aerial gunner's wings. He completed a furlough with his wife, the former Lorraine Druckenmiller, recently, and returned to Tampa, Fla., with her. Stanley Kubat, now Seaman 1/C, entered the Navy July 21, 1944, and completed his boot training at Bainbridge, Md. He was sent to Radar School at Little Creek, Va., and then to the Philadelphia Navy Yard, his present base. He also completed a short leave. Both are graduates of Bethlehem Technical High School and are former employes of the Bethlehem Steel Company. Another brother, Peter Kubat, who served in the African campaign, was recently discharged.
