Two of the three sons of Mr. and Mrs. James Krasnai, 1107½ East Third Street, who are in service have recently received promotions, the parents have learned. They are Pfc. Joseph E. Krasnai, U. S. Marine Corps, and Pfc. Anthony J. Krasnai, U. S. Army. Both were promoted from private to private first class.

Pfc. Anthony Krasnai has also been awarded the Purple Heart, the good conduct badge and the infantry badge. He took his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and went overseas in March 1944. He served in Africa and Italy with the 338th Infantry and has recently been transferred to an Ordnance Ammunition Battalion in Italy. He entered service October 1, 1943.

Pfc. Joseph Krasnai entered service December 11, 1941, and expects to be discharged next month. He received his basic training at Parris Island and Camp LeJeune, went overseas in July, 1942, and served at Guadalcanal, New Zealand, New Britain, and Cape Gloucester. He was sent back to the states in July 1944 and is now stationed at Camp LeJeune, N. C.
