**YOUNG SOLDIER CABLES
GREETING TO FAMILY**

"Best wishes for Christmas and the New Year" is the gist of a cablegram received today by Mr. and Mrs. John McNerney, 921 East Fourth Street, from their son, Jack, who is now stationed in Africa with the U. S. invasion force. Pvt. McNerney entered the Army on June 13, 1942 and received his basic training at Ft. Meade, Md. He was later transferred to Camp Pickett, Va., and now has crossed the ocean to fight. He is a graduate of Bethlehem Catholic High, studied at Moravian College and was employed at the Bethlehem Steel plant before entering the Army. Letters from the young man reveal that he is well and enjoying his experiences.
