**S-Sgt. John Caffrey
Reported Wounded
In Belgium Action**

Mrs. John R. Caffrey of 32 West Elizabeth Avenue has received word in a telegram from the War Department that her husband, S. Sgt. John R. Caffrey, was wounded in Belgium January 13. He served with an armored force of General Patton's Third Army.

S. Sgt. Caffrey entered the service November 11, 1942 and received training at Camp Polk, La. and Camp Barkley, Tex. Following desert training he was stationed at Camp Cooke, Calif., before going overseas to England in September, 1944 and then to France and Belgium.

Prior to entering the service he was graduated from Easton High School with the class of 1930 and East Stroudsburg State Teacher's College in 1934. He had been employed as manager of the Allentown office of the Personal Finance Company. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. John Caffrey, reside on Butler Street, Easton.
