Now An Ensign



In an impressive ceremony staged recently at the United States Naval Reserve Midshipman's School, Columbia University, George Joseph D'Angelo, son of Mr. and Mrs. J. Mario D'Angelo, 217 Adams Street, graduated with the rank of Ensign.

Ensign D'Angelo, aged 20 years, a 1941 graduate of Liberty High School, ranked in the upper third of a class of 1350. He enlisted in the Navy, November, 1942, and was called to active duty in July, 1943. He attended Swarthmore University as a member of the V-12 program.

Prior to his enlistment, Ensign D'Angelo enrolled for pre-medical study at Muhlenberg and Lehigh Universities. While at Lehigh, he was a member of the Chemical Society, the R. W. Hall pre-medical society and was elected to Alpha Epsilon Delta, a national honorary pre-medical fraternity. He has been active in wrestling at Lehigh and Columbia Universities.

At Columbia, Ensign D'Angelo was appointed honorary midshipman's officer, a rank conferred because of ability to handle men and excellence in scholastic studies.
