## Lieut. David Williams, Reported Missing, Now Nazi Prisoner SEP 20 1943

Mr. and Mrs. William John Williams, of North Third Street, Bangor, have received word through the International Red Cross and the American Red Cross, that their son, Lt. David L. "Douse" Williams, is a prisoner of war of the German government. This news was received by the Williams family, yesterday morning in a telegram from the National Headquarters of the Red Cross in Washington, D. C. However, no further details were given in the telegram, which indicated that a letter, with additional information was forthcoming.

Lt. Williams was reported missing in action in the European theatre of operations on August 21, in a letter to his parents from the War Department. He was a bombadier and had served in the U. S. Army for two years following his induction.
