Capt. James Ottinger At Mather Field

Mr. and Mrs. Lloyd Ottinger, 65 Warren Street, Fountain Hill, received word that their son, Captain James Alan Ottinger, has arrived at Mather Field, Cal., after serving overseas as pilot of a B-24 Liberator bomber for more than a year.

Capt. Ottinger holds the Air Medal and Oak Leaf Clusters. He received his silver bars July 21 after completing his tour of combat missions.

Two brothers have also seen action overseas. They are First Lt. Samuel H. Ottinger, who was returned to the States October 23 and discharged at Indiantown Gap. Lt. Ottinger was commanding officer of a radar station in Assam, India, since May, 1944. Another brother, T/Sgt. David E. Ottinger, completed a tour of 43 combat missions and was returned to the States April 21 to receive his discharge.
