Bath Soldier Missing, Says War Dept.

Mrs. Marie Bond, R. D. No. 2 (Irish Settlement), was notified that her son, Technician Fifth Grade David M. Bond, has been reported missing in action in France since Aug. 1st.

Tech. Bond is 27 years old and has been in the European area about 11 months. He was in various camps in America for basic training as follows: Camp Polk, La., Camp Pickett, Va., Indiantown Gap, Pa., Rice, California, and Camp Tillman in Texas.

Another brother, Pvt. Edward C. Bond, is at Camp Atterbury, Indiana, where he serves in an Air Corps ground crew. He is 23 years old and entered the service one year ago, April 23rd. He is expected home on furlough. Their brother-in-law, Pvt. Lawrence A. DeCesare, is an instructor in the Air Corps at Truax Field, Madison, Wisconsin.

The Bond brothers are sons of Mrs. and the late Cyrus Bond, David, reported missing, worked for some time on the farm of George Florey,
