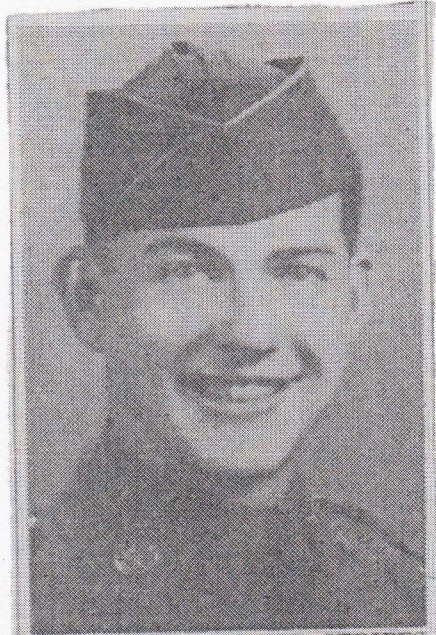


Simmons Jr., Oliver B.
