Just prior to his recent furlough here, Milton J. Goodman, this city, was elevated to the rank of Captain in the United States Airforce stationed at Walker Army Airfield, Victoria, Kansas. Captain Goodman is attached to the Second Air Force legal office and is the Trial Judge Advocate of general and special courts martial. In civilian life, Captain Goodman was an attorney having been associated with the law firm of Mauch and Goodman for ten years prior to his entry into service. Captain Goodman was drafted as a private in the armed forces on August 12, 1942, and was soon assigned to officers' training school at Miami Beach, Fla., receiving his commission as Second Lieutenant in the Army Air Force on August 21, 1943. As Second Lieutenant, he was assigned to Hill Field, Ogden, Utah, where on January 19, 1944, he was elevated to the rank of First Lieutenant. Later transferred to the Walker Army Airfield and Victoria, Kansas, his present station, he was soon assigned to the legal office where he has been given trial judge duties. Captain Goodman's wife, the former Evelyn Bloom, of Cicero, Ill., is with him at Victoria, Kansas. Captain Goodman is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Ben Goodman, 421 East Union Boulevard, this city.
