Milton J. Goodman Returns To Law Firm From AAF

Having served in the Army Air Forces for 3½ years, Capt. Milton J. Goodman, local attorney, has returned to this city and resumed his position in the law firm of Mauch and Goodman, 203 West Fourth St.

Inducted into the Air Corps as a Private in August, 1942, Attorney Goodman received his basic training at St. Petersburg, Fla. He graduated from the Air Corps Radio School in Chicago, Ill., and from the Officers Candidate School, Miami Beach, Fla., where he was commissioned a Second Lieutenant in August of the following year.

During his last 29 months of service, Capt. Goodman served as Legal Assistance Officer, Claims Officer, Trial Judge Advocate of General and Special Court Martials, Summary Court and Legal Officer.

A son of Mr. and Mrs. Ben Goodman, he is a graduate of Lehigh University and Dickinson Law School. After passing the Pennsylvania State Bar examination, he was admitted to the Northampton County Bar in October, 1932, at which time he became associated in the

practice of law with Russell C. Mauch.
