Pfc. Ralph Snyder Killed In Action In German Area

Private First Class Ralph Stephen Snyder, son of Mr. and Mrs. Chester L. Snyder, 1544 Oakland Street, was reported killed in action in Germany March 3, in a War Department telegram received by his wife, Mrs. Jean Snyder.

Pfc. Snyder had been serving

overseas since December, 1944 with an infantry unit. He entered the service July 1, 1944 and completed his basic training at Camp Croft, South Carolina.

In addition to his parents he is survived by his wife and daughter, Sue Anne, born last June. Also surviving are six brothers, Sgt. Edward C., in Italy; Kenneth C., PhM3/C, in Florida; Art and Donald, Bethlehem; Frederick, Allentown; Roy, New Bloomfield, Pa., and one sister, Helen, this city.
