Brothers Have Reunion In Corsica

S-Sgt. Russell A. Mease and H. LeRoy Mease, F 1-c, sons of Mr. and Mrs. Frank J. Mease, Riegelsville R. D. 1, after not having seen each other for 18 months, met accidentally in Corsica several weeks ago.

S-Sgt. Russell Mease enlisted in the Army Air Corps, June, 1942, and after much training in camps at Georgia, Carolina and Mississippi, graduated as Radio Technician from Walterboro, S. C. He has been awarded the Good Conduct Medal and the presidential citation for outstanding work in the Tunisian, Sicilian and Italian campaigns.

F 1-c H. LeRoy Mease entered the Navy, August, 1943, and while at the Great Lakes Naval Training Center, volunteered for P. T. boat duty. After receiving a diploma for having completed his study of motor torpedo boat duty, he left for overseas April, 1944. LeRoy had been stationed on the island of La Mad-

dalena before being shipped to Corsica.

Another brother, Pfc. Merritt Mease is overseas in the South Pacific. He left for service with the Quartermaster Corps, January, 1943, and received extensive training in refrigeration, after which he was sent overseas. Pfc. Mease had been stationed on Guadalcanal before being sent to New Georgia.

All three brothers are graduated from Springfield High School and prior to induction were employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
