## Hellertown Sergeant Killed Three Days After Birthday

Three days after he observed his twenty-first birthday anniversary S. Sgt. George Marish, son of Mrs. Mildred Marish, of 737 Easton Road, Hellertown, was killed in action in Belgium. A message from the War Department yesterday afternoon announced his death as of Jan. 7, and on that date his mother and family

were observing the Russian Christmas.

Sergeant Marish was a paratrooper with the 17th Airborne Division, in which there are quite a number of Hellertown young soldiers. He was a member of the graduating class of the Hellertown High School in 1942 and afterward was employed at the Saucon plant of the Bethlehem Steel company.

Sergeant Marish was inducted April 6, 1943, and had been in the European theater for several months.

January 31, 1945
