Pfc. John H. Mosko, 27, U. S. Army, son of Mrs. Julia Mosko, 907 Evans Street, is a prisoner of the Italians, according to information received some time ago from the War Department, it was learned today. He had been reported missing in action on December 24, of last year.

In service for more than a year, the young man, following his training in this country, landed in England and later in Africa. A brother, Joseph, is in the U. S. Air Corps. Before donning the country's uniform he was an employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company.
