## **"Missing" Nazareth Paratrooper Writes Parents**

Heartening news was received by Mr. and Mrs. Raymond Stoudt, 332 South Broad Street, from their son, Pvt. Harold Stoudt, a paratrooper who was reported to be missing in France since D-Day, June 6, by the War Department. Pvt. Stoudt wrote that he is safe and well somewhere in France. The letter was dated June 24th.

His parents were informed in a War Department telegram Saturday that he was reported missing in France since June 6. The news about his apparent safety was not yet confirmed by the War Department.

Stoudt entered the service April 22, 1943, and has been in the European Theatre of Operations since last November. He is nineteen years old.
