Hurt in France

News of the recent wounding in France of Pfc. Michael Belcak, one of four service sons of Mr. and Mrs. John Belcak, 1118 Furnace Street, Hellertown, has just been received from the War Department, by the parents. There were no details but the telegram stated subsequent information would be forwarded.

The young soldier, who is one of the tallest ever sent from this community has been in the service since September 24, 1941. He is six feet four inches tall. He has been overseas about a year, having received his advanced training in Northern Ireland. In the United States he trained at Ft. Leonard Wood and Camp Forrest, Tenn., in California and other places.

His three brothers in the service are John, with the Marines in the South Pacific; George, in the Army at Ft. Dix, N. J., and Joseph in the Marines, recently heard from in California and now probably enroute to a combat area.
