"Somewhere in France" last month, Pfc. Moyer went to his quarters and found his life-long friend, Cpl. Jack Koplin, 2115 Eaton Avenue, spread out on his bunk, where he waited Moyer's return for more than two hours.

Koplin is a radioman with an infantry division and has been serving overseas for the past seven months. Moyer has been serving overseas with the Military Police for two years. The two soldiers played side-by-side in the Liberty High School Band and Orchestra and graduated together. Neither has seen anyone from this vicinity since going overseas.
