Former Cook Earns Army Citation

Pfc. Paul M. Lehman, formerly a cook at the Sun Inn, is one of the enlisted men whose work was a contributing factor to the outstanding record attained by Squadron A, 370th AAF base unit at the Hammond, La., air field. For its achievements, Squadron A has been awarded the Meritorious Service Unit Plaque by the Third Air Force.

The basis for the award to the Hammond Squadron was "for super-for performance of duty and for achieving and maintaining a high standard of discipline." This was evidenced by a four-month record of no trials by court martial, no absences without leave, only one punishment under the 104th Article of War.

Lehman and his unit were also recommended because of the outstanding appearance of personnel, equipment and installations, superior military courtesy and enthusiastic execution of orders.
