Given Commendation  
Ribbon for Service**

First Lt. Lucy J. Liggett, Army Nurse Corps, has been authorized to wear the Army Commendation Ribbon by direction of the Secretary of War "because of meritorious services performed from April 8, 1945, to December 31, 1945, as Head Nurse, Neurology and Aphasia Ward, Newton D. Baker General Hospital, Martinsburg, West Va."

The citation accompanying the award continued, "Accomplishing highly professional assignments with distinction, Lt. Liggett has reflected great credit on her profession and the military service."

Lt. Liggett graduated from St. Luke's Hospital in 1931. She has been in the Army since January 15, 1943, having been assigned to duty at the Station Hospital, Camp Pickett, Va.; Camp Tyson, Tenn.; 24th Evacuation Hospital with the 1st. Army in England, and the Newton D. Baker Hospital in West Virginia.
