Local Soldier Wounded Fourth Time

Sergeant Russell Bauer, 628 Ontario Street, has been reported wounded in action for the fourth time in the fifteen months he has served overseas. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Rolland Bauer received an official telegram stating he had been wounded in France, January 24.

He was wounded while serving with the 5th Army in Italy, January

31, in the invasion of Anzio, May 24 and July 14 in the push to Rome. He had been sent to the French theatre sometime in November when he became a member of General Patton's 7th Army.

Sgt. Bauer received his Infantry training at Camp Swift, Texas; Fort G. Meade, Md., and went overseas in November, 1943. He is a graduate of Bethlehem High School and before entering the service, was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company.
