Returns to States After Three Years In Caribbean

ATLANTIC CITY, N. J., Jan. 12, 1944.—Technical Sergeant Herbert W. Miller, of Bethlehem, has reported to the Army Air Forces Redistribution Station No. 1 here following his return to the United States after three years of service in the Caribbean theater of war.

While at the Redistribution Station, Sgt. Miller will be carefully examined and interviewed to determine where his lengthy training and combat experience can be utilized to the greatest advantage in the Army Air Forces.

The husband of Mrs. Kathryn Elizabeth Miller of 24 West Walnut Street, Bethlehem, Sgt. Miller served as a mechanic and crew chief on a Mitchell medium bomber.

Entering the service Oct. 16, 1939, Sgt. Miller underwent training at Langley Field, Va., before embarking for overseas duty.

January 12, 1944
