Nazareth Man "Missing" Says Government

Pfc. Raymond J. Christman, Jr., 21, son of Mr. and Mrs. Raymond J. Christman, Sr., 370 Belvidere Street, Nazareth, is reported missing in action in Luxembourg, according to word received by his parents.

The telegram from the War Department stated that Pfc. Christman has been reported missing in action since December 22 in Luxembourg and that if further details are received his parents will be promptly notified.

Pfc. Christman entered the U. S. Army on March 4, 1943. He received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga., and was an instructor at Fort Meade, Md., before being sent to England in August, 1944. He has seen action in France, Belgium, Germany and Luxembourg and was with the Keystone Pennsylvania 28th Division of the First Army.

He was graduated from Nazareth High School, class of 1942, and prior to entering the service was employed by the Nazareth Planing Mill.
