Major Sanna Transferred to Arkansas Post

Major Alfred A. Sanna, Commanding Officer of the Jayhawk Ordnance Works since January 6, 1943 has been transferred to the Maumelle Ordnance Works, Little Rock, Arkansas, as Commanding Officer, effective September 5, 1944.

Major Sanna came to the Jayhawk Ordnance Works from the Office of the Field Director Ammunition Plants, St. Louis, Missouri. He was called to active duty on June 9, 1941 and served for a year and a half in the Office, Chief of Ordnance, Washington, D. C., before being transferred to St. Louis.

Major Sanna is a graduate of Lehigh University, class of 1931. He has been a Reserve Officer since February 1932.
