Hellertown Boy Dies In War Three Weeks After Sailing

Pvt. Joseph J. Beyer, Jr., son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Beyer, of 521 John Street, Hellertown, was killed in action in the European theatre within three weeks from the time he left the United States, according to a telegram received yesterday afternoon from the War Department. The young man who was eighteen years of age last July was a member of an infantry regiment and sailed from this country

January 12, 1945. His death occurred on January 31, 1945, in Germany.

Pvt. Beyer was an only child. He was inducted August 4, 1944 and trained at Camp Blanding, Fla. He was a graduate of the Hellertown High School with the class of 1944 and while a student there was active in amateur theatricals and was a member of the debating team. He also was a talented violinist and pianist.
