Lieut. Louis H. A. Feher, son of Mr. and Mrs. John Feher, 1605 East Third Street, is spending six weeks at home on furlough after having returned from islands in the Central and South Pacific, where he

served with the Signal Corps as radar and electronics officer.

A graduate of Lehigh University 1940, he was employed as assistant plant engineer at Lehigh Structural Steel Company, Allentown, when inducted in August 1941. Receiving his basic as a private in the Engineer Corps, he obtained his com-

mission in the Signal Corps and was sent to England in January, 1942, being subsequently transferred to duty in the Pacific in March 1943, where he was promoted to the rank of first lieutenant.
