J. W. Macartney Gets Majority At Monmouth

FORT MONMOUTH, N. J.—It's Major J. W. Macartney now. The Great Neck, N. Y., officer, a graduate of Lehigh University, 1931, is 36 years old and is commanding the Military Police at Fort Monmouth.

Major Macartney was commissioned a second lieutenant in the Reserve in 1931. He became a first lieutenant in 1936; captain July 13, 1942, and major June 25, of this year.
