

# PASS RIGID TESTS FOR ARMY SERVICE

Percentage of Local Selectees

The quota of men of Local Draft Board No. 1, spent to Wilkes-Barre on Friday for a final physical examination, has been accepted and inducted into one of Uncle Sam's fighting units, it was announced today.

Ten of the quota had enlisted in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps; five had been transferred to other boards, and one will be re-examined.
