His last letter received December 22, His last letter received December 22, 1942, was dated December 4. Since that time all other letters written by the parents have been returned. He was reported missing one year and one day after his induction. Prior to his induction, Heydt was employed as a fireman at the Beth-lehem Steel Co. plant in this city.
