**Dr. S. F. Seaman,  
Out of Army, Returns  
To Local Practice**

Dr. Stephen F. Seaman, after serving 39 months with the U. S. Army Medical Corps, has opened offices at 1036 Hamilton St., Allentown, where he is resuming his practice of maternity and diseases of women. Prior to entering the military service in October, 1942, Dr. Seaman practiced at 311 West Fourth St., this city.

Dr. Seaman is a native of Bethlehem. He attended local schools including Bethlehem Preparatory School and Lehigh University. In 1929, he received his M. D. degree from Jefferson Medical College and completed his internship at St. Agnes Hospital in Philadelphia. After practicing general medicine until 1937, Dr. Seaman closed his offices to take up post graduate work at Bellevue Hospital in New York City, where he spent four years as resident obstetrician and gynecologist.

Dr. Seaman is a diplomate of the American Board of Obstetrics and Gynecology and a member of the Philadelphia Obstetrical Society, American Medical Association, Pennsylvania Medical Society and the Northampton County Medical Society. He is associated with the Sacred Heart, Allentown General and St. Luke's hospitals.
