**Local Sergeant Now
"Top Kick" In Britain**

AN EIGHTH AAF FIGHTER STATION, England—First Sergeant Edward A. Goth, 623 Fourth Avenue, Bethlehem, Pa., is head of an ordnance supply company in Col. Don Blakeslee's P-51 Mustang fighter group, which flew from dawn till midnight over France the day of the invasion. The group made dive-bombing attacks on German troop trains and motor convoys and scoured the skies over France for German craft for more than five hours at a time. The group has destroyed more enemy aircraft than any other in England, its score being 399 destroyed aloft, and 186 destroyed on the ground.
