### Juried Exhibition March 23 - April 14, 2001

An exhibition to celebrate unique and diverse imagery presented in a smaller scale.

#### Eligibility:

This competition is for all media, except video. It is open to any artist residing in the United States. All work must be exhibition-ready upon receipt — matted, framed with hanging wires. No glass will be accepted, unless being hand-delivered. Work may not exceed 12" in any dimension (this does not include frame). Final exhibition inclusion will be at the curator's discretion.

#### Slides:

Each artist may submit up to three entries. All curating will be done by 35 mm color slides. One slide per 2-D entry, two slides per 3-D entry. Each slide must be labeled with a red dot in the top right corner and include the artist's name, title of work, medium size and entry number. Slides of accepted works will be retained for the Banana Factory archives.

#### **Entry Fee:**

Each artist may submit up to three works with a total entry fee of \$15. Make checks payable to the **Banana Factory**. Do not send cash. Submit the entry form and fee with your slides. Slides of unaccepted work will only be returned if a self-addressed, stamped envelope is included.

#### Reproduction:

Entry in this competition implies consent for reproduction of accepted pieces for publicity purposes.

#### Liability:

All works will be insured for the sale price, less the commission, while on exhibit at The Banana Factory. Artists are responsible for liability during shipping and works left after the return deadline.

#### Sales:

The Banana Factory will retain a 35% commission on all sales. If work is not for sale, please mark entry form "NFS."

**Curator:** George Sorrels

George Sorrels is professor of art at Kutztown University, Kutztown, Pa., where he has taught since 1973. He has had nine solo shows in Washington, Philadelphia and New York: his latest was at the University of Texas at Austin as a distinguished alumnus. Sorrel's work has won several purchase prizes and awards, and he has been included in over 100 group exhibitions across the country and abroad.
