## Another Local Soldier Dies In French Battle

**AUG 26 1944**  
Pfc. Clare D. Van Billiard, son of Mr. and Mrs. Morris H. Van Billiard, 213 Spring Street, was reported killed in action in France this month, according to a telegram received from the War Department Friday.

Pfc. Van Billiard attended Bethlehem schools and was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company prior to his induction, April 30, 1943. The 20-year-old youth received infantry training at Camp Shelby, Miss., before being sent overseas in June, 1944.
