Abstract: Selma Dietrich Sellers, a 1922 graduate of Bethlehem High School, kept a scrapbook for high school and beyond. Includes "The Girl Graduate" scrapbook, photographs, commencement programs and exercises, and Dietrich's "Music in the Pennsylvania Public Schools" essay from the 1922 commencement ceremony.

Historical Note: Selma Dietrich Sellers graduated from Bethlehem High School in Bethlehem, PA in 1922. After high school, she attended The Bethlehem Conservatory of Music where she graduated in 1924 and went on to teach private music lessons for 40 years. She was married to A. Maynard Sellers.

Scope and Content: Contains a manufactured scrapbook titled "The Girl Graduate: Her Own Words," which is written in and contains photographs and various memorabilia from Seller's time at Bethlehem High School. Also includes loose photographs with identification, articles and obituaries from the newspaper regarding her graduation and members of her class, as well as teachers. Other folders contain two commencement service programs, a commencement exercise program, and an essay written by Sellers titled "Music in the Pennsylvania Public Schools," which was part of commencement.
