

Bath Veteran To Enter West Point

Having been appointed to the West Point Military Academy by Congressman Francis Walter of Easton, 2nd Lt. Kenneth R. Ebner, son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles A. Ebner, Main St., Bath, will leave Wednesday to enter the cadet corps. He is a veteran of World War II.

Lt. Ebner graduated from Easton High School, class of 1944, and entered the service in September, 1944, being assigned to the Army Ground Forces. After receiving his basic training at Fort MacLellan, Ala., he entered Officer's Candidate School at Ft. Benning, Ga., and was commissioned as second lieutenant, Infantry, July 5, 1945. He served as instructor of Infantry Tactics at Camp Wheeler, Ga., from July to November of 1945. The past three months he has been doing special work for entrance to West Point.

A brother Roy A. Ebner, received his discharge from the Army Air Forces October 1945, and is now a student at Lafayette College. He was in the service 42 months, 24 of which were spent in the Southwest Pacific area with the Fifth Air Force.
