Bath R. D. Soldier Serving On Luzon

Pfc. Stanley Heckman, husband of Mrs. Pauline Heckman, Bath R. D. 2, is fighting in the Zambales mountains of central Luzon, with an infantry division. His job is in the message center of an infantry battalion headquarters.

Before entering the Army on October 5, 1942, Heckman was in the employ of the Bethlehem Steel Company. He has been overseas for 17 months, prior to landing on Luzon, serving in Hawaii, New Guinea and Leyte. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Heckman, reside at Bath R. D. 2.

He is entitled to wear the Combat Infantry badge, the Asiatic-Pacific and Philippines Liberation medals, each with battle stars, and bronze arrowhead for making an assault landing on enemy shores.

A brother, Seaman First Class Willard Heckman, is with the Pacific fleet.
