Board No. 3 Accepts Youth Under New Registration.

Charles R. Opp, 329 Conestoga Street, is eighteen years old today, and, obeying the directions of his Commander-in-Chief, he appeared this morning at the offices of his Selective Service Board, No. 3, in the DPA Building, and enrolled for selective service. He was the first registrant of the board under the continuing registration procedure.

Registrant Opp, like the other 18-year-olds who enrolled during the last three weeks of December and those who will follow him, will receive his serial and order numbers in the sequence of his registration, L. R. Drown, chief clerk of Board No. 3, explained today. No National lottery will be held.

Board No.3 held a regular meeting last night with Stanley K. Weaver, chairman; R. Fred Stahl, secretary, and Prof. LaVerne Crum, all members, present along with Chief Clerk Drown and Appeal Agent John Diefenderfer.
