# T-5 Lukanuski, Pen Argyl, Killed in Action

Technician Fifth Grade Stephen F. Lukanuski, 29-year-old son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank Lukanuski, 100 East Main Street, Pen Argyl, is officially listed as killed in action according to a War Department telegram received by his parents at noon today. He had been previously reported as missing in action June 23.

Reported killed in action June 9 in the European Theater of Operations, he had seen action in the D-Day invasion and steadily moved on toward he had seen action in the D-Day in-

The last word received from the deceased was in a letter dated June 4 from England, where he had been for two years. He enlisted January 5, 1942 and received his training at Camp Lee, Va., and Fort Dix, N. J.,

before shipping overseas with an Army Ordnance Division. Prior to his enlistment he was employed by the Well Built-Trouser Company, Pen Argyl. He had also attended Pen Argyl High School, and was a member of the St. Elizabeth Church.

In addition to his parents, he is survived by two brothers: Nicholas, from Tacoma, Washington; James; three sister: Mrs. Mary Bartolocci, Mrs. Stella Pekar, and Helen Lukanuski, of Pen Argyl.
