## Martin Seifert Wounded On September 12

Pfc. Martin E. Seifert of 225 East Ettwein Street, one of the many who participated in the invasion of southern France, was wounded in action on Sept. 12, according to a telegram from the War Department, received yesterday by his sister, Miss Dorothy L. Seifert. He was taken by plane to a hospital in Italy.

A former Liberty High School student, he was inducted into the armed forces in October, 1943, and received his preliminary training at Camp Wheeler, Ga. He was sent overseas in March of this year, landing in Africa. He was subsequently sent to Italy. Before his induction he was an employe of the shipping department of the Laros Textiles Company.
