Private First Class Llewellyn Cope, who was wounded in action in France, June 13, 1944, is now reported missing in action since January 16 in Belgium, in an official telegram received by his mother, Mrs. Merritt Smith, 1032 Mauch Chunk Road. Overseas since September, 1943, Pfc. Cope saw considerable action in France before advancing to Belgium. Prior to entering the service he was employed by the Bethlehem Steel Company. A step-brother, Sgt. Merritt Smith Jr., was killed in action November 2 on Leyte.
