Pvt. Joseph J. Molnar (left), son of Mrs. Veronica Molnar, 1177 Mechanic Street, whose wounding in the North African campaign was reported yesterday in The Globe-Times. Mrs. Molnar received a telegram from the War Department informing her of the injury sustained by her son, from whom she had had a letter dated April 12 just Monday morning.

Advanced to private first class, Joseph's brother, Anthony, continues his training with the coast artillery. He entered the army December 5, last. He is a former employe of the Bethlehem Steel Company and attended the parochial school of St. John Capistrano Church.
