BROTHERS WIN ADVANCEMENT—William, 22, and Warren, 20, Schleifer, left and right, respectively, sons of Mrs. John Steifel, of this city, have been advanced in rating by the U. S. Navy, according to word received by Mrs. Steifel recently. William, is now a seaman, second class, somewhere in the Pacific area. He has not been heard from since June.
