## Quakertown Dr. Advances To Commander

Word has been received in Quakertown of the promotion of Lieutenant Commander Willard H. Tice to the rank of Commander in the U. S. Navy. Cmdr. Tice entered the service on August 12, 1942. On June 30, 1943, at the U. S. Naval Dispensary in Washington, D. C., he was commissioned Lieutenant Commander. One year later, June 30, 1943, he was transferred to Pensacola, Fla., School of Aviation Medicine, to train for Flight Medical Examiner.

Commander Tice is one of Bucks County's well known physicians. Until the time of entering the service, he was in practice with his brother, Dr. Raymond D. Tice, in the Tice Hospital and clinical laboratory. The chief of cardiology at the Quakertown Community Hospital, he is also on the surgical staff as assistant surgeon.

He is Pennsylvania State Medical Examiner, member of the American Heart Association, Assistant Chief Pneumothorax and Chest Clinic in the Quakertown Community Hospital and assistant surgeon for the Reading Railroad at Quakertown.

Commander and Mrs. Tice and their son, Roger, reside at Kingsville, Tex., where Tice is stationed. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Walter T. Tice, reside in Quakertown.
