Catherine Windemuth, Army Nurse, Weds Lieut. E. Schrader

Mr. and Mrs. E. J. Schrader, 522 Edgeboro Boulevard, received a letter from their son, First Lieut. Edwin A. Schrader, announcing his marriage to Second Lieutenant Catherine Windemuth, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A. Windemuth, Rockford, Ill.

The wedding took place July 27, 8:30 p. m., in the 513th Regimental Chapel, at Camp Forest, Tenn. The ceremony was performed by the army chaplain. Lieut. and Mrs. B. Leland, stationed at Camp Forest, were the attendants.

Second Lieut. Schrader is a member of the Army Nurses' Corps for the past one and a half years and

has been stationed at Camp Forest.

Lieut. Schrader was graduated from Bethlehem High School, Georgetown University, Washington, D. C., from where he received his B. S. degree in Foreign Service. He enlisted in June 1941 and received his basic training at Camp Wheeler, Ga. July, 1942, he volunteered as a parachute jumper later being a paratroop instructor at Ft. Benning, Ga. August, 1943, he became a member of the 513th Parachute Infantry Regiment and is now an instructor and platoon leader. He received his specialized training at Camp McCall, N. C.
