M. M. 3-c Russell E. Rader, survivor of the U. S. S. Princeton, which was sunk October 24 in the battle of Leyte and holder of the Purple Heart, is spending a 30-day leave with his wife, the former Marie Kerschner, 1035 Seneca Street. Overseas for 18 months, he had been confined to a Naval Hospital after the Princeton was sunk. M. M. Rader enlisted in the Navy, October 2, 1942, and received his boot training at Bainbridge, Md. His mother, Mrs. Benjamin Smith, resides at 411 West Eighth Street. A brother, Arthur, is a captain serving in the armed forces.
